

The Alaska Association of Figure Skaters Presents: “Holiday Through the Years” 2018 Holiday Ice Show

Welcome! You have been invited to participate in the AAFS annual Holiday Ice Show. **The show will be presented Saturday December 15th and Sunday December 16th at 1:00pm at the Dimond Center Ice Chalet.** This year the theme will be “Holiday Through the Years” featuring classic, oldies and new-age holiday songs. If you would like your skater to participate, please read this information page and complete the attached registration form. There will be a \$100.00 fee per skater, due with each registration and if you want to do a solo, it will also be an additional \$10.00 (or \$5.00 each pair member). (Make checks payable to AAFS.) This fee includes a group costume. Refunds will only be for family emergency. Costumes will be ordered for group numbers and will become property of the skater after the show. Additional accessories may be required, i.e., tights, turtle neck shirt, hair accessories, etc. at the participant’s expense. **All female skaters must provide their own pair of over-the-boot skating tights in toast/nude/suntan color. All male skaters will need black pants.** Solo and pair skaters will be required to provide their own costumes.

ALL GROUP PRACTICES ARE MANDATORY: Practices will be held in a 30-45-minute time slot on Thursday and/or Friday evenings and/or Saturday mornings for 5-6 weeks. You must be available for any day. (Please list any time conflicts on your form). Rehearsals will begin in November. You will be notified by email of the time of your child’s first practice. A complete practice schedule will be given out at your first practice. There will not be any rehearsals during Thanksgiving weekend. Group coaches reserve the right to schedule off-ice practices and additional ice practices as needed. Skaters may not miss or be tardy for ANY practices.

Failure to attend practices may result in dismal from the show without a refund.

THE FULL CAST IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE FOLLOWING ON-ICE SHOW REHEARSALS:

FULL CAST DRESS REHEARSAL ON THURSDAY DEC 13th 5:00-8:00pm

FULL CAST DRESS REHEARSAL ON FRIDAY DEC 14th 6:45-8:45pm (If needed)

Group assignments will be decided by committee and all decisions are final and non-negotiable. All group music will be assigned. You must be a full or associate member of AAFS or a current member of AAFS Learn to Skate USA program in order to participate in the show. If you request a solo, you must hire a registered coach or choreographer. All solos will be chosen by lottery if the numbers of applicants exceeds the time allotted for solo spots. Priority will be given to FULL

AAFIS club members for solos and music selections. Pre-Preliminary and higher level solo skaters may choose their Holiday music. The ice show committee will need to approve all music. Every effort will be made to accommodate music requests. If you do not select a piece of solo music at the time your form is returned, the show committee will select it for you. Some songs will not be available due to the music selected for group numbers. Have multiple selections in mind.

Non-Test level and Basic Skills soloists’ music will be assigned and possibly shared with another skater. If music is shared, one skater will perform their solo on the Saturday show the other will perform their solo at the Sunday show. These days will be assigned. All soloists must participate in a group number. **NOTE TO SOLOISTS:** The show music will be compiled on a master CD. If you need your music cut, please provide a digital or CD version of your song to

Chairperson by 11/01/18. If your coach is going to cut your music, please provide your cut music by 12/01/18.

Coaches: please see Chairperson about time lengths for music.

Are you willing to help with the show?

We will need parent volunteers for the show. Volunteers may be required to complete Safe Sport training seminar. Please indicate on the registration form if you are able to volunteer for any of the following things:

GROUP PARENT/COSTUME CAPTAIN: One-two parents to sit with each group during the dress rehearsals and both shows. This person must be responsible for getting the kids to the staging area and assist with costumes.

DRESSING ROOM: Eight females (4 for Sat. and 4 for Sun.) are needed to help in the girl’s dressing room for dress rehearsal and both shows.

SEWING/ALTERATIONS: Minor alterations of costumes

CLEAN-UP CREW: We need 2-3 people after dress rehearsals and both shows to pick up seating area, staging area and dressing room.



- I/we agree to be respectful and courteous to all coaches, choreographers, volunteers and other skaters. Skaters, parents, coaches and volunteers must follow a strict code of conduct and that disrespect of anyone will be cause for removal from the show.
- I/we understand rehearsals & shows may be photographed and recorded for AAFS media purposes.
- I/we understand that all practices/rehearsals are mandatory. Multiple missed practices or tardiness may result in dismissal from the show. There is only a limited amount of time for group practices. Please follow the direction of all coaches and choreographers. Do not disturb the attention of other skaters. If a skater's behavior is distracting to the coach or other skaters, they will be asked to leave the ice and be given an absence for that rehearsal.
- I/we understand that parents, friends and family will not be allowed inside the Ice Chalet during Tech Rehearsal, Dress Rehearsal or Shows (unless they have been previously assigned to a volunteer position.)
- I/we understand that no food or drink is allowed in the facility (except water) while the skaters are in costume during the dress rehearsals or both shows.
